

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: 90 Devonport Road, Tauranga.

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from LT McGuinness Limited, notification of intention to operate a crane at 90 Devonport Road, Tauranga, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, could constitute a Hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE, I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- 1. Prior to the crane operation, a representative of LT McGuinness Limited is to contact Tauranga Airport (Ray.Dumble@Tauranga.govt.nz) and request a Notice to Airmen (NOTAM) is issued for commencement of the crane operation; and
- 2. On receipt of the date and time for the crane operation, Tauranga Airport is to authorise the issue of a NOTAM and liaise with Aeropath for inclusion into the appropriate AIP SUP for the duration until end of 2024; and
- 3. On receipt of the crane operation, Tauranga Airport is to email the Tauranga Airport user group, as appropriate, to notify of the operation of the crane; and
- 4. The crane is to be lit in accordance with CAR Part 77, Appendix B; and
- 5. The crane is not to exceed 58m above ground level (AGL); and
- 6. LT McGuinness Limited is to advise CAA, Quote 23/77/39, (aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz) when the crane operation is complete and no longer in use at 90 Devonport Road; and
- 7. When the crane operation is complete and no longer in use, LT McGuinness Limited is to ensure they liaise with Tauranga Airport (Ray.Dumble@Tauranga.govt.nz) to restore the Aeronautical Publications to normal.

This Determination of Hazard shall become final on 28^{th} April 2023 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of Hazard shall not expire but may be revoked, in writing, by the Director.
