

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: 16–20 Williamson Avenue, Grey Lynn, Auckland.

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Hamish William McKoy, Senior Technical Specialist, having received from Smith Cranes Limited notification of intention to operate a crane at 16–20 Williamson Avenue, Grey Lynn, Auckland, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- The crane shall be lit with an appropriate obstacle light in accordance with Civil Aviation Rule Part 77, Appendix B; and
- Smith Cranes Limited are to advise the CAA (Quote 22/77/44 <u>aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz</u>) when the crane operating at the Williamson Avenue site is lowered and no longer in use.

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on $1^{\rm st}$ April 2022 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on $1^{\rm st}$ October 2023 or when the crane is lowered and no longer in use.
