



**NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Titan Cranes Limited – 2 Riccarton Avenue, Christchurch**

PURSUANT TO Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Sean Turangarau Kere Rogers, Manager Aeronautical Services, having received from Titan Cranes Limited, notification of intention to operate a crane at 2 Riccarton Avenue, Christchurch, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, could constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE I HEREBY ISSUE a

**DETERMINATION OF HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE**

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

1. The crane shall be lit with an appropriate obstacle light in accordance with Civil Aviation Rule Part 77, Appendix B; and
2. Titan Cranes are to provide details of the crane to Aeropath to allow for a NOTAM to be issued for the duration of the operation; and
3. Titan Cranes shall contact Garden City Helicopters prior to the operation and advise that the Heliport is closed for the duration of the lift; and
4. Titan Cranes shall contact the Christchurch District Health Board to request that the Heliport be closed for the duration of the operation and that a NOTAM for the closure is issued by the Christchurch DHB as Heliport operator; and
5. Titan Crane shall advise the CAA when the crane operating at Riccarton Avenue is no longer required.

This Determination of Hazard shall become final on 1<sup>st</sup> August 2020 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of Hazard shall not expire but may be revoked, in writing, by the Director.
