

NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE DETERMINATION: Mahurangi Forest, between Wellsford and Warkworth.

<u>PURSUANT TO</u> Rule Part 77 of the Civil Aviation Rules I, Hamish William McKoy, Senior Technical Specialist, having received from Contact Energy Limited, notification of intention to erect a Met Tower at Mahurangi Forest, between Wellsford and Warkworth, conducted an aeronautical study in consultation with such persons, representatives and organisations as I considered appropriate.

After completing the aeronautical study, I am satisfied that the proposed action, if executed, would not constitute a hazard in navigable airspace.

THEREFORE, I HEREBY ISSUE a

DETERMINATION OF NO HAZARD IN NAVIGABLE AIRSPACE

in respect of the above notification.

The following conditions are specific to this Determination:

- 1. Contact Energy Limited shall ensure that the mast is lit and marked as specified in their Part 77 proposal dated 2^{nd} December 2021; and
- 2. Prior to the mast being erected on the preferred site, Contact Energy Limited is to advise Aeropath, Quote 22/77/41, of the location (info@aeropath.aero) and request the mast is included in the EAD database and if necessary the relevant aeronautical publications; and
- 3. At least 3 months prior to the expiry date of the Determination, Contact Energy Limited is to ensure that another Part 77 proposal is submitted on Form 24077-01A so that a new Determination can be issued for the following 18 months; and
- 4. Contact Energy Limited is to notify CAA (<u>aeronautical.services@caa.govt.nz</u>) when the mast is eventually lowered and removed off site.
- 5. Contact Energy Limited is to notify Aeropath (info@aeropath.aero) when the mast has been lowered and removed off site so that this can be removed from the EAD database and AIP if necessary.

The provisions of this determination are in addition to and not in derogation of the provisions of any other Act, or any orders or regulations made thereunder

This Determination of No Hazard shall become final on 18th March 2022 unless a petition for review is received by the Director prior to that date.

This Determination of No Hazard shall expire on 18th September 2023.
