Notes on use of the CAA 24047/05 Deregistration form

What is this form used for?

This form is used to request the Director within 14 days of becoming aware of the aircraft being destroyed, lost, stolen or withdrawn from use, to remove the aircraft from the New Zealand Register of Aircraft.

Who should complete this form?

The owner/operator of the aircraft.

If the owner/operator is not available (eg, deceased) then please complete the CAA 24047/05A form.

What is the fee for deregistration of an Aircraft?

There is no fee required to deregister your aircraft.
