Exemption from the Requirement in Civil Aviation Rule CAR 101.205(a)(3)

PURSUANT TO Section 37 of the Civil Aviation Act 1990,

- I, Graeme Harris, Director of Civil aviation, being satisfied that—
 - (a) The action taken in holding a pilot licence issued under Part 61 is as effective as holding a pilot qualification issued by a model aircraft association; and
 - (b) the risk to safety will not be significantly increased by the granting of this exemption,

HEREBY EXEMPT—

Persons who hold a pilot licence issued under Part 61

who may wish to operate a model aircraft on or within 4 km of an aerodrome

FROM—

the requirement in Civil Aviation Rule CAR 101.205(a)(3) that a person must not operate a model aircraft on or within 4 km of any aerodrome unless the person is the holder of, or under the direct supervision of the holder of, a pilot qualification issued by a model aircraft association approved by the Director,

This exemption shall remain in effect unless withdrawn in writing by the Director.
